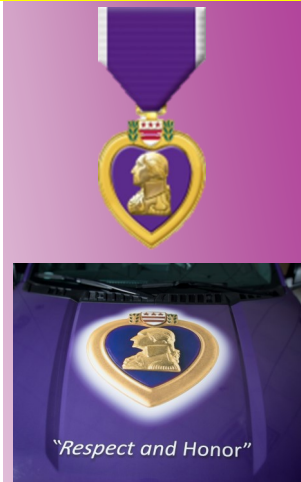




MOBILITY IS FREEDOM
